



Icons of Depth and Complexity

Icon	Student-Friendly Definition
 <p>Unanswered Questions</p>	<p>The unsolved, the puzzle, the dilemma, the unknown.</p> <p><i>How do you determine the importance of a question? What are the origins of this unanswered question? Is there a way to test possible answers or outcomes?</i></p>
 <p>Details</p>	<p>The clues, facts, parts, elements, specifics.</p> <p><i>What distinguishes this from other things? Which details are most important?</i></p>
 <p>Ethics</p>	<p>The biases, controversies, dilemmas, values, morals.</p> <p><i>What are the ethics within this story/event/moment? How might culture influence ethics? How are ethics and rules related?</i></p>
 <p>Language of the Discipline</p>	<p>The importance of the words and how experts use them.</p> <p><i>What words and tools are used in this area?</i></p>
 <p>Patterns</p>	<p>Repetition, cycles, recurring, sequence, replicated, or able to be replicated.</p> <p><i>Describe the patterns. How do the patterns compare? How are the details of the patterns related?</i></p>
 <p>Rules</p>	<p>The spoken and unspoken rules, the laws, the method to organize.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Text</p> <p><i>How do we measure the value of a rule? Why are there different types of rules based on the event/person/time/conflict?</i></p>
 <p>Trends</p>	<p>How something or someone changes, an increase or decrease over time.</p> <p><i>What do the trends tell you about the topic? What influences trends? What are the results of the trend?</i></p>
 <p>Big Idea</p>	<p>Something that is almost always true, supported by evidence.</p> <p><i>What evidence is necessary to support the big idea? How do we decide if the evidence is strong or weak?</i></p>
 <p>Multiple Perspectives</p>	<p>Different points of view, different roles.</p> <p><i>What are the perspectives of all involved? How does our experience influence our perspective?</i></p>
 <p>Across Disciplines</p>	<p>The connections among subjects or areas.</p> <p><i>How does one topic appear in many subjects? What is the value of studying or learning a topic in various areas?</i></p>
 <p>Over Time</p>	<p>The past, present, and future of an issue, person, event.</p> <p><i>How does history help us predict the future? How did _____ change from the beginning to the end?</i></p>
